INTRODUCTION:

The Government Team arrived Lohum Imenyi at about 11.00am. The team was headed by Amaechi Chukwu.

Mr Ndubuisi Ago introduced the team and they were welcomed by HRH Eze Okechukwu Ago and the community.

Mr Amaechi Chukwu addressed the community with emphasis on the reason for the introduction of this programme. From his address, it was clear that the Abia state realised, though lately, the in the past budgetary system, whereby the government decides it all. In order to involve the communities in the development plans, the Abia state decided that from 2019 development Budget planning, communities have to be approached for their input.

For the above to become feasible, a random selection of communities from across the L.G.A in Abia state was made, and Lohum

Imenyi was one of the communities selected from Bende Local Government Area.

Finally, it was noted that the programme is not a political issue neither is the Community development project identification an issue for the Royal Fathers, President General, the women nor the youth alone but it is for the present of the entire community. DEVELOPMENT NEEDS IDENTIFICATION PROCESS

Mr Chukwu advised the community on the process of identifying the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS.
