The Minutes of a joint meeting of Isiala Asaokpuaja Autonomous Community Council and a team of Community Development Officers from Aba South L.G.A comprising Mrs. Onyeché Onyedikachi, Mrs. Ngozi Ajah (HOD) and Comrade G.C.D Nwogu (HOD). The meeting was held at the palace of Hrh Eze Dr F.I Nwafor on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2019. At about 2pm. The meeting was declared open and after a short prayer delivered by the Chairman of the Community Deacon Godwin Nwangwa and also blessed the kolanut offered by the Royal Father.

**INTRODUCTION:** The Secretary of the Community, Chief Emma Evurulobi introduced the members of the Community Council comprising of the palace members, community council members, the women council and the youths.

**OPENING SPEECH:** In her opening remarks, the community Development Officer, Mrs. Onyeché thanked all that were present in the meeting, especially Hrh Eze Dr F.I Nwafor whom she described as vibrant and determined. She went ahead to highlight the specific purpose of this visit. Basically to assist the community achieve goals on any project embarked upon.

Continuing on her speech, she advised the Community to register their town union with the ministry of cooperatives. After which we can apply to the Executive Governor of Abia State Dr Okezie Ikpeazu for assistance in the project, we can still apply for any other project through the General Manager Abia State CSDP. She also directed that after the first batch of the project we may embark upon. The Community Members present at the meeting unanimously agreed to embark and apply for the following projects.

1. Reconstruction/Rehabilitation of our civic center.
2. The Development of the Achiaru market.
3. The Development of the Eze's palace.

The Community Development Officer also explained that any project of interest the community will provide her counterpart fund.

In response, Hrh thanked the August visitors for the visit to the Community. He stressed that the backward of the Community was owing to hatred, animosity and problems created for us by the sister community. The Royal Father however, promised that we will work hard to recapture all that was lost. He also promised to work cooperatively with the team in order to move our Community forward. He solicited for greater assistance of the visitors to make our dreams come true.

The Traditional Ruler also made mention of rebuilding the palace. Finally, the project officer encouraged us to organize age grade unions, make contributions that can help the community through collection of monthly dues. Contributing, the youth president Elder Onyebuchi Alozie, argued that the project if started, let it not be abandoned and also how fast it can be pursued. Answering to this question, the Development Officer maintained that already we have not started and had not been included in the 2019 budget. That it is done according to when community got started. She further advised us to be fast and make the project estimate. She also made us realize that the project is being sponsored by the Fed. Government and endorsed by the Governor.

The Youth President thanked the visitors for their impressive speech and promised to visit their office in due time. Also the community Chairman Deacon G. Nwangwa expressed his appreciation over the whole exercise and promised speedy work on the projects. While the Secretary Chief Emma Evurulobi sponsored the vote of thanks and closing prayers. So at about 3:30pm the meeting closed.






