REPORT: Through the training of the participant whose name Hon. Ugochukwu Uwalaka the TC Councilor Ndume ward identify himself as one the delegate associated to the programme at Michael Okpara Auditorium made an elaborated report on how development have to our dear community which he notify that the community lacks many things suggested to be considered and need to be identify by the community to the government for consideration on the 2020 budget which require resolution by the entire community.

The delegate to the organizing committee on this matter Mrs. Onyemachi Cynthia CDO and Mrs. Adaeze Nnenna Ude, the Technical Officer lamented that the government want a transparent resolution on whatever we choose as part of the our budget to rendered to the government for consideration, she further mention the areas the government are looking into i.e. Agriculture, Health, Education, Oil and Gas, Commerce and Industry etc.

After the resolution of the men, women and the youth of Lodu Ndume Ibeku Umuahia North Abia State. Mr. Ugochukwu Akwada address and concluded on the most important thing the government should look into as agreed by the entire community are as follows;

1. Redefine convert with standard drainage: elder Onyenkwere Ohabuiro lamented vigorously that this the major problem the community at large are facing, children cannot go to school because of flood and bad roads, motor vehicle cannot pass freely to the neighbouring village like Umuana, to Ikot Ekpene road and Agbama olokoru.
2. Complete equipment on our health center: elder Onyenkwere Ohabuiro also lamented on the necessary need of the health for health care ,first aid and standard rehablitaion to members of the community and state at large .
3. Completion of Lodu Community hall: it was agreed that the community at large don't have hall where they can have their meetings and other social gatherings and event, we further resolve to be considered as one of the budget the government should look into and build for us.

After all resolution were made by the members of the community for consideration the meeting came to an end with a closing prayer led by elder Onyenkwere Ohabuiro at about 08.28am.




