ACCOUNTING POLICIES

In line with the adoption of the IPSAS in Nigeria, a NCOA and standardized format of GPFS have been designed and introduced for adoption by all tiers of Government in Nigeria. Consequently, some notable accounting policies were employed in preparing and presenting the attached financial statements. The accounting policies employed are in accordance to New Model Financial Memoranda For Local Governments in Nigeria, 1992, and as amended in 2009. The policies are also in compliance to International Public Sector Accounting Standards. They include:

1. **Basis of Preparation**

The GPFS shall be prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with IPSAS and other applicable standards as may be defined by relevant statutes. IPSAS Cash basis accounting method was adopted in the preparation of the financial statements. Under this method, Income and Expenditure are recognized as at when received and paid respectively.

3. **Accounting Period**

The accounting year (fiscal year) shall be from 1st January to 31st December in line with the National Treasury Circular Ref. **OAGF/CAD/026/V.1/102 of 30th December, 2013**. Each accounting year is divided into 12 calendar months (periods) and shall be set up as such in the accounting system.

4. **Reporting Currency**

The GPFS shall be prepared in the Nigerian Naira

7. **Notes to the GPFS**

Notes to the GPFS shall be presented in a systematic manner. The Items in the Statements should cross reference to any related information in the Notes and the financial statements. It shall follow the format provided in the Accounting Manual.

Local Government** for the year ended December 31, 2019, have been examined by me as provided in Chapter 5 of Abia State Local Government Law No. 2 of 2006, in accordance with New Model Financial Memoranda For Local Governments, 2009; and also in compliance to International Public Sector Auditing Standards; and other extant financial Regulatory Authorities. And I hereby certify that the accounts were prepared on the basis of International Public Sector Accounting Standards pertaining to Local Government systems; subject to observations made in both Audit Inspection Report thereof, and this report thereto.

STATEMENT 1

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION AS AT DECEMBER 31, 2019

ASSETS

2. The Cash Assets as at December 31, 2019, amounted to ~~N~~41,231,096.18. This figure includes Cash and Cash Equivalents of N34,191,396.18, and the outstanding Receivables of ~~N~~7,039,700.00.

LIABILITIES

3. The Cash liabilities as at December 31, 2019, amounted to ~~N~~147,058.00

NET ASSETS/EQUITIES

4. Matching liabilities against the assets results in net assets/equities. As at December 31, 2019, the accumulated Reserves stood at ~~N~~41,084,038.18.

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE
FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2019

REVENUE

5. Total accrued revenue for the year amounted to the sum of N2,031,180,163.81 over 62.9% of the amount, that is N1,276,517,875.77 was realized as statutory revenue Federal Account Allocation Committee (FAAC). The sum of N18,256,276.02 was internally generated. This amount constituted about 0.9% of the total accrued revenue. A sum of N384,816,307.17 represents Value Added Tax (VAT). This amount constituted about 18.94% of the total accrued revenue and other capital receipt of N218,823,529.41 representing 10.77% of the total accrued revenue. The remaining 6.53% was transfer from consolidated Revenue Fund, which amounted to N132,766,175.44.

EXPENDITURE

6. Total expenditure incurred during the year amounted to N1,945,151,535.84. This comprises N265,386,856.83 for Salary; N174,360,630.82 for Over Head; Transfer payment of N1,505,404,048.19 being Grants and Contributions.

ASSETS

7. During the year, the Local Government acquired a non-current assets on Property, Plant and Equipment.

SURPLUS/ (DEFICIT)

8. Surplus/(Deficit) from Operating Activities for the year amounted to N41,084,038.18.

9. The total net cash in/(out) flows arising from the year's operating, investing and financing activities amounted to (N98,574,779.26).

10. The current year total net Cash Flows from all Activities in cash and cash equivalents (N98,574,779.26) of added to cash and cash equivalents N132,766,175.44 of at the beginning; and the amount for Certificate of Deposits, summed up to N34,191,396.18 being Cash and cash Equivalents at the end.

11. The Cash and Cash Equivalents at the end are in agreement to the Closing Cash Balances and Certificates of Deposits. Vide Note 26 for details.
