

overnor Alex Otti, OFR, announced the full takeover of the Aba Mega Mall by the Abia State Government as his administration has paid off vested interests. Governor Otti disclosed the acquisition and full takeover of the mega-mall on Sunday, 4th May, during the grand finale of a 3-day Mega Crusade of the Lord's Chosen Charismatic Revival Ministries, which was held in Aba Mega Mall Complex in Osisioma LGA of the State. The Governor, whose presence electrified the religious gathering, said, "I want to say that the place where you are, before now, there was a dispute. But just about three weeks ago, we resolved the dispute, paid off everybody that was being owed, and the place has reverted to the State Government."







Governor Otti, received in audience a delegation of Nigeria Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (NEITI), led by the alternate Chairman of the Board, Ambassador Sunday Adoli, who paid him a working visit. They applauded Governor Alex Otti's leadership style and said that his policies align with the values NEITI represents.

"Abia State, under your (Gov. Otti) leadership, is fast becoming a reference point. We have followed with keen interest and the transformational reforms you have introduced. Reforms that prioritise fiscal discipline, infrastructure renewal, access to quality health care, education, urban regeneration and corporate governance. These are not political statements.

"As an agency that promotes transparency and accountability in the extractive industries, NEITI is particularly pleased to note your commitment to fiscal openness and your emphasis on the social contract between government and citizens.

"This aligns perfectly with the values that NEITI represents, values anchored on proven results, youth, public trust and sustainable development," Amb. Adoli noted.

"NEITI would do well to pay close attention to the evolution of this new ecosystem with respect to the business of exploration of mineral resources. It should set up systems that are pro-Nigeria in terms of reporting and industrial accountability to avoid a repeat of the costly mistakes of the past.

"Stakeholders are encouraged to pay attention to the



unfolding dynamics of the old and new energy order to enable the development of appropriate paradigms for optimizing operations and cutting out sharp practices within the extractive industry. Whatever happens, the best path for us will be to embrace the new opportunities that are bound to come with the transition to low and non-carbon energy sources," Gov. Otti stated.







he Governor received in audience a delegation of Course 47 of the Armed Forces Command and Staff College of Nigeria, led by the Deputy Commandant and Director of Studies of the command, Rear Admiral Aniefok Uko. The delegation came to Abia as part of the senior course curriculum called environmental study tour of Nigeria army, with the theme "Harnessing Grassroots Intelligence for Enhanced Internal Security." Governor Otti used the opportunity to charge the security agencies to pay attention to intelligence gathering in order to nip issues of insecurity in the bud.

"A lot of times, if you pay attention to intelligence, you will be able to nip in the bud majority of the cases before they happen. So, pay attention to intelligence. It's good that, that is what this course is about too. "

We have also held a strong view that security starts from intelligence. Thorough and well put together intelligence would always predict and sometimes put the forces in a state of readiness," Gov. Otti stated.



Security Council Meeting. Briefing the media after the meeting, the special adviser to the Governor on Security matters, Navy Commander MacDonald Ubah (Rtd.) reiterated the commitment of the State Government to sustain the calm and peaceful atmosphere in the State. He thanked all heads of government security agencies in the State for attending the routine monthly security council meeting to evaluate the level of security around the

State with a view to strengthening and consolidating the gains. The Special Adviser to the Governor on Security Matters, Rtd. Navy Commander MacDonald Ubah commended the cordial and harmonious working relationship between the State and the security agencies including the collaboration among the various security agencies in intelligence gathering and information sharing to combat crime and criminality.

he State Government has announced the commencement of a comprehensive statewide tax enumeration and automation exercise, targeting N120 billion Naira Internally Generated Revenue (IGR) target for 2025. The Commissioner for Information, Prince Okey Kanu, who disclosed this in a press conference in Umuahia, highlighted the achievements of Governor Alex Otti's administration over the past 23 months, noting significant progress in infrastructure, urban renewal, education, healthcare, and economic empowerment. "The government is unlocking every viable avenue of Internally Generated Revenue. We are confident that with the support of our people, we will meet and even surpass our 120 billion Naira target by year-end," Prince Kanu stated.

The Information boss emphasized that the enumeration and automation exercise, being undertaken in partnership with Access Bank, will be integrated with the Abia State Social Identification Number (ABSSIN). He added that the initiative would create a robust database of residents and businesses, enhance revenue forecasting, and strengthen equitable tax administration across the state.

bia State Government has commenced the construction of a befitting Governor's Office in Government House, Umuahia. speaking during a Sabbath worship held at the Unity Chapel, Government House, Umuahia, Governor Otti explained that he delayed the commencement of work in Government House because it was not a priority at the beginning of his administration, saying that though the Government House was important, it was not as important as many other things that have direct impact on the people of the State.

"So, the challenge was, which one do we do first? As a student of economics, we have brought with us a

scale of preference. And, we sat down and said, okay, everything is important, some are more important than others. We didn't think this place (Government House) was more important than your salaries. We didn't think this place was more important than the primary healthcare centres. We didn't think it was more important than our schools. We didn't think it was more important than making education free at basic level so that our children and those who cannot afford to pay will have the opportunity that you and I had.

"We didn't think this place was more important than the roads that were dilapidated, the offices that were decrepit..." the Governor stated

Aba Promise Kept Carnival: The Aba community mobilized themselves and rolled out the red carpets thanksgiving carnival tagged PROMISE KEPT CARNIVAL, converging at Umuagbai Secondary School premises, Port Harcourt road, Aba in celebration Governor Alex Otti, OFR, for keeping to his promise of reconstructing and completing the dilapidated Port Harcourt Road, abandoned for over 3 decades by previous regemes.

Governor Otti, who recalled his efforts in fixing the Port Harcourt Road as against the attacks of the noisy opposition, said that he replies the shameless opposition with performances. He also revealed that the amount of money spent by the immediate past administration in the reconstruction of Port Harcourt road, which was not realized was much more than what his government spent in realizing the Road.

"But, we have always ignored them. And we have continued to ignore them. We respond with performance. But, there is a response I want to give. "So, listen to the response. In 2017, they awarded this Port Harcourt Road. The amount at that time was N9.8 Billion. And they paid out the entire money. But the Road was not done.

'So, when in 2025, the Road cost N36.5 Billion, they started making noise. So, I said, since you people understand mathematics, the average exchange rate in 2017 was N333 to a Dollar. Now, if you apply that,





the N9.8 Billion was actually USD29 Million (equivalent)

"In 2025, at the average exchange rate of N1,600, N36.5 Billion is actually USD22.8 Million equivalent. So, let us do the math."USD29 Million and USD22 Million, which one is higher? But, the real issue is that in 2017, USD29 Million was spent, and no Road was done. In 2025, USD22 Million was spent and a standard Road is done and delivered for use" Gov. Otti explained.

Governor Otti thanked Aba people for their sustained support for him right from 2015 when he contested the Governorship election for the first time and said that Aba has been giving him massive support since



then.

Speaking on behalf of the Aba business community and the Aba Landlord's Association, Chief David Ogba Onuoha, Chief Leo Nnodi Okoye, Chief Alphonsus Odigbo and the Chairman of the occasion, Ide John Udeagba said that they decided to put the event together to show appreciation to the Governor, and emphasized that though he has done great things in Aba, but Port Harcourt Road is top among others.

They described the event as not just a celebration of restoration but a vote of confidence on the Governor. adding that with his achievements, he has already completed political campaigns for his re-election.





ithin the month in review, Governor Alex Otti, OFR, lauded Nigeria's First Ladu, Mrs. Oluremi Tinubu, CON, for distributing food items to vulnerable groups in Abia as part of her Renewed Hope Initiative (RHI) and Social Investment Food Outreach Programme. overnor Alex Otti, OFR, attended the Interdenominational Thanksgiving Service, to mark his 2nd Year Anniversary in office which was held at the premises of Ibeku High School, Umuahia. Speaking during the event, the Governor told Abians to expect multiple commissioning of projects in the State within the next 30 days. "After the 2nd Anniversary, at the minimum, 30 days, we are going to be commissioning projects.

"We have 200 Primary Healthcare Centres spread across the 184 wards. Information available to me is that at the minimum, half of them are ready for commissioning.

"We have Schools, including our Smart Schools. We have 20 of them (Smart Schools), at least 2 of them should be ready for commissioning by now and 18 of them are receiving serious attention.

"We have another 221 Schools at different stages of rebuilding and retrofitting, they would also be ready.

"A lot of Roads have been completed, and will be commissioned within the next 30 days," the Governor assured. The project commissioning has already commenced.

Peter Fayose has commended Governor Otti

Governor Otti disclosed that the new Laws encapsulate thoughtful legislative provisions for achieving his Government's vision in critical areas such as performance-based administration, accountability, and delivery of good governance. He commended the State House of Assembly for its focused leadership and commitment to the new Abia and for providing strong legislative support to the programme and policy outlays of the Executive branch of Government. Some of the 18 bills signed into law include: Abia State Senior Citizens Law 2025, Abia State Road Maintenance Agencu (repeal) law 2025, Abia State Estate Development Agency (Repeal) Law 2025, Abia State Orientation Agency (Amendment) Law 2025 among others.

The Attorney General of the State and Commissioner for Justice Barr. Ikechukwu Uwanna revealed that with the 18 laws, some agencies have been moved from reporting directly to the office of the Governor to their line Ministries for optimal performance.

he Executive Governor of Abia State, His Excellency, Dr. Alex Chioma Otti, OFR, attended the May 27th Children's day celebration and took the traditional March-Past salute from Abia Pupils and Students at the Umuahia Township Stadium, Umuahia. In a speech titled "Celebrating the Stars of Tomorrow," Governor Otti assured that never again will education be taken to the background in Abia State. in his word, "As a government, we shall continue to give priority attention to programmes and policy choices that would have positive impact on the future of Abia children

Speaking during the event, the Governor disclosed that his administration has so far committed over N40 Billion in offsetting arrears of salaries and pensions owed by previous administrations in the State, adding that his government has ended the dark era of owing civil servants and pensioners in the State.

"When we came in, salaries were being owed. Pensions were also being owed. Some of our institutions of higher learning, including the Abia State University Teaching Hospital, had lost accreditation.

"Within 24 months, we have spent well over N40 billion in payment of arrears of salaries and pensions. And, I'm glad to report to you today that as we speak, I'm not sure we are owing anybody.

"At the moment, one of our vendors is working to ensure that we digitalize our operations. Computers have been made available, and very soon, the old practice of carrying files up and down will be a thing of the past.

"By the end of this year, December 31, precisely, if you are in any part of Abia State, you can be sure to get network and Internet connectivity.

"Of course, the first ever Abia Digital Mall, and that is to be completed with other e-commerce platforms so that you can, from the comfort of your home, place an order and the goods will be delivered right to your doorstep," Gov. Otti stated.

Beyond offsetting arrears of salaries and pensions owed by previous administrations in the State, the Governor highlighted some of the achievements of his administration health, education, waste management, road infrastructure, institutional reforms and securing and keeping the State Safe among others.







The campaign, jointly executed by the National Primary Health Care Development Agency and the Abia State Ministry of Health, is aimed at delivering life-saving vaccines to children across the state. In her goodwill message, Mrs. Otti emphasized the critical importance of immunization in safeguarding the health and future of Abia's children. She called on mothers, caregivers, and community leaders to ensure no child is left behind in the state's drive to achieve full immunization coverage.





Virtual Participation in Human Rights Training for Law **Enforcement Agencies:**



Her Excellency participated virtually in a significant Human Rights Training organized by Vision Spring Initiatives (VSI) at the Police Officers' Mess Hall in Umuahia. The training focused on equipping police officers and law enforcement agents with the requisite knowledge and skills to prevent and respond to violence against women and girls. In her address, Mrs. Otti commended the organizers for the timely initiative and described law enforcement officers as frontline defenders of human rights. She advocated for the establishment of specialized gender desks in police stations across the state, adequately equipped and staffed by trained personnel to provide responsive services in collaboration with community stakeholders.

20 May 2025: Summary of Nigeria Solar for Health Project Launch @ Abia State

he Executive Governor of Abia State, His Excellency Dr. Alex Otti OFR, launched the Nigeria Solar for Health Project (NISHP) and inaugurated the State Steering Committee. The governor was represented by the Deputy Governor, His Excellency Engr. Ikechukwu Emetu FNSE.

The NISHP is a project that will provide 24/7 access to electricity, to health facilities and productive load users in Abia State.

The Nigeria Solar for Health Project (NISHP) is an European Union funded project with selected states (Abia, Enugu, Akwa Ibom, PLATEAU and Ogun) and implemented by NTU International A/S that aims to leverage Nigeria's renewable energy potential to enhance healthcare services and promote sustainable socioeconomic development.



The EU through the Delegation of the European Union to Nigeria and ECOWAS committed the sum of EUR 2,080,000 (approximately -NGN3,723,616,000 per state) for the capital expenditure and cost of technical assistance for deploying the solar systems.





Abia State Government in return, to support the project sustainability has committed the sum of EUR 624,000 (approximately NGN 1,117,084,800) for Retrofitting facilities, Warehousing, Power evacuation to PUEs, Operations and Maintenance, Security, Local staffing & Logistics.


















Abia Medical City site tour:

ithin the month, the Abia State Commissioner for Health, Prof. Enoch Ogbonnaya Uche took the press on a tour of the site of the Abia Medical City Project located in Amapu Umuovo, Isiala Ngwa North LGA, extending to Isiala Ngwa South as well. Prof. Uche highlighted some of the features of the Medical City. According him, "This medical city is the first quaternary hospital in this country that would take care of all levels of complicated healthcare issues."

The Medical City sits on about 200 hectares of land covering seven communities within Isialangwa South and North LGAs, would cost \$1.3 billon and would be funded by development partners, MKP International Holdings with Abia State Government providing land, security and goodwill.

The Medical City would have a 1,000-bed ultramodern healthcare facility that can cater for every healthcare need of the people.

"Apart from the ultra-modern medical facility, there also going to have a tourist city. The medical stepdown hotel, there will be a five-star hotel and there will be another five-star tourist hotel.

"You're also going to have an ultra-modern oncology centre. As you may well know, cancer care is one of the reasons people leave this country for care abroad.

"Whether you are talking about radiotherapy, you're

talking about radiosurgery, radio-oncology, you're talking about emerging therapies, you're talking about the neuro chemotherapeutic agents.

"All those are going to be available here with the bestin-class medical experts that can come in from all parts of the globe to be part of the workforce in this place. So this ecosystem will also house a modern surgical center that can take care of laparoscopic surgeries, robotic surgeries.

"It will also take care of all forms of brain, spine, orthopedic, organ transplantation, cardiac transplant, and cardiac surgeries, name it, any level of surgery. There will also be a place for cosmetic surgery.

The Medical City would also have an ultramodern children's hospital, a fertility centre, ophthalmology centre, organ transplantation, diagnostic centre, a hub for digital health technologies among others.

The Medical City would equally have research institutes that will be affiliated with the best hospitals and universities in the world.





















bia state government has provided the matching funds in a 10 billion Naira Abia State Government -Bank of Industry fund for SME's in the state. bia State has procured 20 electric buses which will be rolled out in the next 2 months. Governor Otti disclosed this while addressing Aba community who organized a thanksgiving carnival tagged 'Promise Kept Carnival' at Umuagbai Secondary School premises, Port Harcourt road, Aba in celebration of the Governor for reconstructing and completing Port Harcourt Road, abandoned for over 3 decades.
